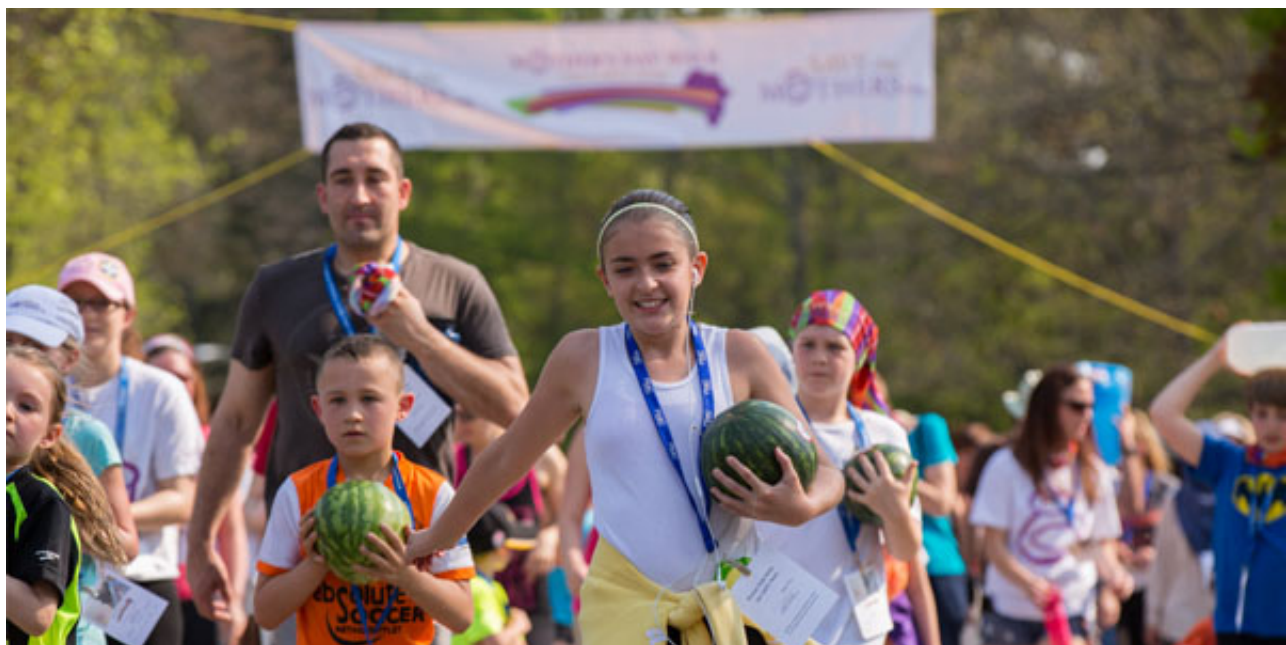

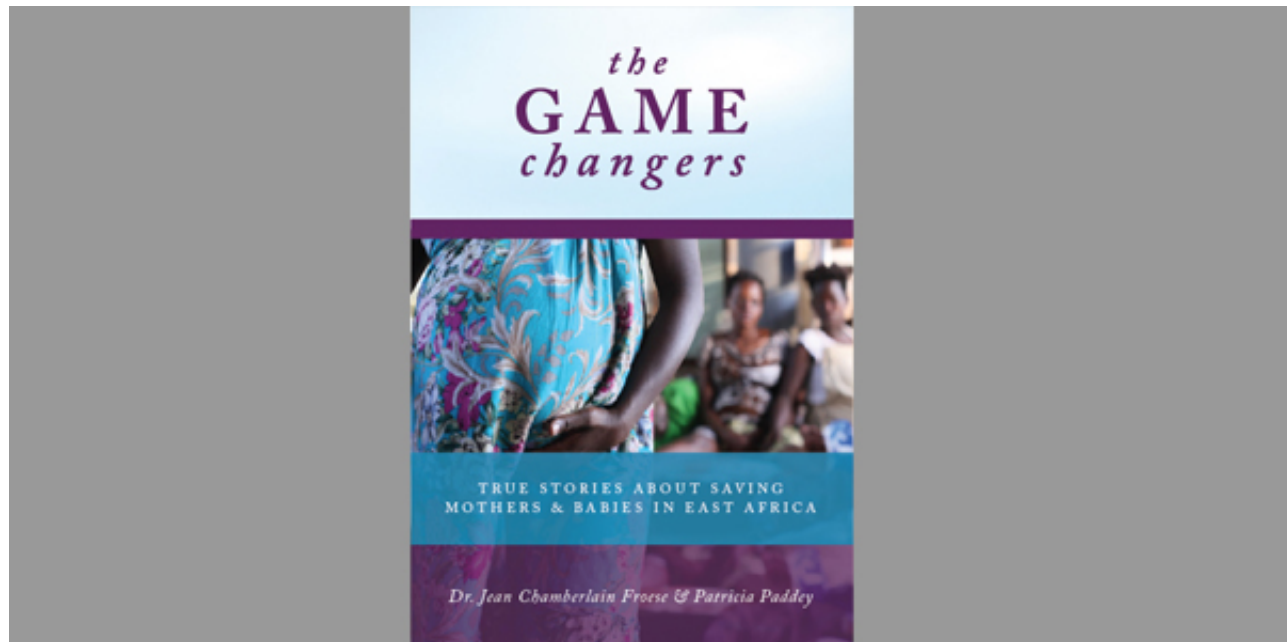
It's an international movement - in celebration of mothers
